- o Bring your Insurance Card and payment for necessary co-pays
- o Wear loose-fitting comfortable clothing. NO lipstick, contact lenses, makeup.
- o Leave Jewelry at home
- o Bring phone and fax numbers of referring physicians you would like reports sent to
- YOU MUST HAVE A RESPONSIBLE ADULT TO DRIVE YOU HOME
 - Your driver must stay during your procedure. Plan for someone to be with you 4-6 hours after your procedure as well.

MEDICATION GUIDELINES



- You may take your other necessary medications as you usually would
- On day of the exam, NO diuretics should be taken (Lasix, Aldactone, HCTZ, etc)
- Diabetic medications require special instructions
- BRING A LIST OF YOUR CURRENT MEDICATIONS (including over the counter meds)
- If you are a female, you must notify someone if there is any possibility you maybe pregnant.

5 days prior to your procedure (

- STOP TAKING: Iron pills, Coumadin, Plavix, Aggrenox, Pletal, Effient, Pradexa, Xarelto, Eliquis etc. (unless otherwise instructed)
- Avoid eating any <u>raw</u> fruits, vegetables or nuts(COOKED or CANNED VEGETABLES AND FRUITS ARE ALLOWED)

IF YOU HAVE NOT HAD A BOWEL MOVEMENT 1-2 DAYS PRIOR TO YOUR EXAM, TAKE 1 BOTTLE OF MAGNESIUM CITRATE (which is sold over the counter) AT 8PM ON

day prior to your procedure (

- FOR BREAKFAST: you may have full liquid diet (milk, plain oatmeal, plain yogurt, pudding, nut free ice cream, cream soups)
- REST OF THE DAY: CLEAR LIQUID DIET ONLY. NO SOLID FOOD
 - Strained Fruit Juices without pulp (apple, White Grape or lemonade) No red/purple juices.
 - Water (drink at least 64 ounces through the course of the day)
 - Clear broth or bouillon, coffee or tea, (without milk or non-dairy creamer)
 - All of the following as long as they are NOT colored RED or PURPLE
 - Gatorade- Snapple
 - Carbonated and non-carbonated soft drinks (7-up, sprite, ginger ale)
 - Kool-Aid (or other fruit flavored drinks)
 - Plain Jell-O (preferably clear or yellow, without added fruits or toppings)
- AT 6:00PM: Take first dose of Prepopik laxative
 - o Fill the dosing cup provided with cold water to the 5oz line.
 - o Pour in the contents of 1 packet of Prepopik
 - o Stir for 2-3 minutes until contents dissolves and drink the entire contents.
 - You must then fill cup to 8oz line with plain water and drink one 8oz cup every 15 minutes until you have consumed FIVE 8oz cups of water.

Day of your procedure

- 6 HOURS PRIOR (at): Take second dose of Prepopik laxative
 - o Fill the dosing cup provided with cold water to the 5oz line.
 - o Pour the contents of remaining packet of Prepopik
 - o Stir for 2-3 minutes until contents dissolves and drink entire contents.
 - You must then fill cup to 8oz line with plain water and drink one 8oz cup every 15 minutes until you have consumed THREE 8oz cups of water.
- 4 HOURS PRIOR (at): NO FURTHER LIQUIDS BY MOUTH(no gum,candy,ice or water) (except a sip of water with your medications)
