Do NOT eat ANY nuts, seeds, or popcorn one week prior to your procedure

PREP INSTRUCTIONS FOR COLONOSCOPY – Clenpiq

** If you are taking <u>Plavix, Coumadin (Warfarin), Lovenox</u> or any other prescribed blood thinners, it is very important that you notify the nurse for instructions as to when to <u>STOP</u> these medications prior to your procedure. If you are taking 325MG Aspirin, switch to 81MG daily 7 days prior to your procedure & stay on this leading up to the procedure.

DAY BEFORE:

- 1. You **MUST** be on a clear liquid diet **ALL DAY.** (NO SOLID FOODS)
- List of liquids: Tea, Black Coffee (no creamer), coke, sprite, diet sodas, chicken or beef broth, Jell-O, popsicles, apple juice, cranberry juice (natural red), Gatorade, Powerade, and water. Absolutely no RED Jell-O or RED/PURPLE products. No Orange Juice, Milk, or Milk Products.
- You will need to take any Thyroid, Blood Pressure, Anxiety and **only take a half dose of your diabetic medication**.
- 2. At <u>6:00pm</u> complete the following steps using your CLINPIQ KIT:
- Drink one bottle of CLENPIQ
- Follow with FIVE 8-oz cups of water (use cup included in kit)

*Check off as you finish each cup _1 _2 _3 _4 _5 *Complete within 1 hour

3. At <u>9PM</u>, MIX one 238gram container of MiraLAX in 64 oz of water. Drink half (32oz) of this mixture over 1 hour.

*If you're still not clear by 10 pm drink another 300ml bottle of magnesium citrate.
*If you have not had any bowel movements by 10:30 pm call 972-562-4430, press option 1 to page our doctor on call.

DAY BEFORE: 5 hours before your procedure time

- At _____AM/PM drink the other bottle of CLENPIQ and follow with at least THREE 8-oz cups of water.
 *Check off as you finish each cup: __1 __2 __3*Complete within 1 hour*
- 2. You **MUST HAVE TRANSPORTATION** from the facility by an adult family member or friend otherwise, your procedure will be canceled.
- 3. You may take blood pressure or heart medication with <u>just a sip</u> of water **early** on the morning of your procedure.
- 4. **<u>NOTHING</u>** by mouth 5 hours prior to procedure(s)
